Teresa attends memorial events including - Bastille Day for the French community, Kokoda Track Commemoration, Naval Association Events, ANZAC Day March, Chinese, Indian and Korean Veterans Commemorations, the Victory in the Pacific and Victory in Europe Wreath-laying Services to name but a few, preparing and laying wreaths for some 25 events annually.

Most importantly however, Teresa supports the Australian American Association, Brisbane Inc in preparations for events and supporting its President, Mike Harris, in inviting dignitaries, organising the running of the Annual Battle of the Coral Sea Wreath-laying Commemoration, which is attended by the Association's Patron - the Governor of Queensland Her Excellency the Honourable Dr Jeannette Young AC PSM, also the US Consul General the Honourable Christine Elder, and a wide range of distinguished dignitaries, of which Graham Perrett has represented the Australian Government on these occasions. There is always one volunteer that stands in my mind as the super glue that holds the Association (which is based in Coopers Plains) together, and she is Teresa.

Teresa organises over 70 representatives to lay wreaths at the Annual Battle of the Coral Sea Commemoration and schedules everyone in from all areas including the US Navy 7th Fleet, its Fleet Band, the Australian Navy Band and the set up and catering.
