83rd Anniversary of the Battle of the Coral Sea Commemoration Service held on Saturday 3rd May 2025.

Arrival at the Battle of the Coral Sea Service were - Brisbane City Councilor Julia Dixon of Hamilton Ward, and the Hon Tim Nicholls MP State Member for Clayfield and Minister for Health and Ambulance Services, and Australian American Association Life Member.

Prior to the commencement of the service, the Hon Tim Nicholls MP unveiled a Memorial Lectern made by the Blackbutt Woodworking Group Association, which has the words - "Battle of the Coral Sea" inscribed on its front. A Plaque is also fixed in remembrance of two US Navy Aircrew who were lost from the US Navy USS Pensacola, prior to its arrival in the Brisbane River on 22nd December 1941.

The two-aircrew lost were - Ensign Robert F. Rogers A-V (N) United States Naval Reserve, and RM1c Glen Dwayne Saxton, United States Navy Service.
